Announcement

- The proceedings of SiMCRT2011 will be published from IOS Press (Amsterdam, the Netherlands) as a volume of the book series.
- All speakers are invited to arrange their manuscripts for possible publication in this issues
- The authors will sent those to the organizer by e-mail, **no later than 31 January 2012.**

Preparing the manuscript

- the manuscript should be submitted “camera-ready”, but without page numbers or running headlines.
- the instructions and tools for the preparation of an Electronic Camera-Ready Manuscript in Word or LaTeX) can be downloaded from the Authors Corner on the IOS website at http://www.iospress.nl/authco/instruction_crc.html

How to submit the manuscript files

- The author should submit all of the following:
 - source files (either MS Word or LaTeX)
 - identical PDF files, with all fonts embedded and of high resolution. (If you are using Acrobat Distiller, please select the job option Press Optimized.)

How to submit the manuscript file (Continued)

- 1) The articles should have filenames that are numbered in the correct order and correspond to the order in the table of Contents, as follows:

01_filename.doc 01_filename.pdf

02_filename.doc 02_filename.pdf

The "filename" part can be the author's name, article title, or some other reference.

- 2) If authors prepared their contribution in LaTeX, with multiple files, all of these should be zipped together, and the same file naming conventions observed, for example:

– 01_filename.zip01_filename.pdf

How to submit the manuscript file (Continued)

- 3) If the manuscript is made up of more than one section or part, the files should be organized accordingly, in numbered directories.
- 4) Note that it is essential you *submit no more than one version of any item.*
- 5) The manuscript should not exceed 15 pages.

 - 2) by providing us with a URL where we can download the files (in that case, please contact us first by email when you are ready to submit the manuscript).
